Each mirrored PDF carries a SHA-256 hash and retrieval timestamp printed inline above. The mirror is secondary by default; the originating regulator URL remains the authoritative source. Should the originating URL ever return 404, the row above is annotated and the mirror becomes the only public copy available.

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
